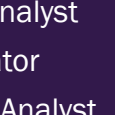

## CYAI INCENTIVE FUNDING

CYAI is funded by the U.S. Department of Labor's (DOL) Employment and Training Administration (ETA) Office of Apprenticeship (OA). Incentive funding is available for the development of cybersecurity registered apprenticeship programs (RAPs) for youth aged 16–21. CYAI experts will help you design, register, and launch your RAP. Incentive funds can be claimed when a qualifying youth begins their apprenticeship.

### FUNDING DETAILS

- CYAI partners may receive up to \$400/apprentice.
- There are no restrictions on how funds can support RAPs.
- CYAI partners may braid different programs and services together, including other OA grant funds, to provide comprehensive training and support for apprentices.
