CYAI INCENTIVE FUNDING

CYAI is funded by the U.S. Department of Labor's (DOL) Employment and Training Administration (ETA) Office of Apprenticeship (OA). Incentive funding is available for the development of cybersecurity registered apprenticeship programs (RAPs) for youth aged 16–21. CYAI experts will help you design, register, and launch your RAP. Incentive funds can be claimed by the registered apprenticeship program when a qualifying youth begins their apprenticeship.

FUNDING DETAILS

- CYAI partners (RAPs) may receive up to \$400 per apprentice.
- RAPs can braid funding with other resources.
- Typical use of funds includes prep/costs for certification exams, books, competition registration fees, equipment, and transportation.
- Funds may not be applied to wages.
